- 3 Details of psychotherapy training, qualifications, and membership(s) of psychotherapy organisation(s).
- 4 Details of psychiatric clinical placement or other hospital experience.
- 5 Post-graduate training, including details of psychotherapy courses, before and/or after qualification, with dates.
- 6 Details of all previous psychotherapy/analysis, with names of therapists/analysts (with their affiliations), dates, numbers of hours, and frequency.
- 7 Details of all previous supervision, individual and/or group, with names (and affiliations), dates, numbers of hours, and frequency.
- 8 Details of all previous clinical work, with numbers of hours, and frequency at which worked.
- 9 Details of all Jungian courses and seminars attended, including during training.

- 10 Details of any significant physical or psychological medical conditions, past or current.
- 11 Details of any complaints made against you during the course of your professional work.
- 12 A statement on why you wish to become a Jungian analyst.

We are interested in what you hope to gain from participating in the course and from your subsequent membership of AJA.
